1. Be respectful of all and their ideas and writings.
2. THINK like a writer. WRITE like a thinker.
2. Come to class prepared EVERY DAY
3. We will have a writer's notebook. Take one from back shelf 16 pages is all we need
 - We will have approximately 16 prompts generated by Sahli
 - Time is determined by all sorts of things but usually 10 minutes or a page
 - Grade will be 5 points per entry based on
 - Quality content OR
 - Quantity—full page
 - Notebook will **NOT** leave room 248. This is not a homework activity.
 - Date and Prompt upper Right Corner
 - “College Rule” notebook with 20 pages. Use old notebook if you can.
 - Notebooks will be graded at the end of approximately 16 entries.
 - Stories can be future stories for class
 - Absent students will make up writing prompts upon their return.
 - This is your chance to write without fear of correction. It is the easiest 80points you will have **IF YOU KEEP UP TO DATE.**
4. Formal projects will go through multiple drafts each being evaluated and revised. Final will be expected on time. Final Edits will receive one grade loss per day late.
5. All documents turned in as Final Edits will be turned in to turnitin.com. Late turnitins will be rewarded with loss of a grade.
6. ANY Plagiarism will result in a 0(zero) for offender with no opportunity for REDO.
7. ALL papers must be original to each assignment. No reworked papers from previous years or previous assignments will be accepted. NO duplicates from other classes will be accepted.
8. All documents to be turned in must be word processed unless otherwise noted.
 - Follow the formatting requirements
9. At times we will discuss mature issues in a mature manner. If you are uncomfortable with any of the comments or conversation topics, you are expected to speak with me. We can excuse those students who are uncomfortable, but I will not know without communication.
10. Grades are separated into two categories. Missing one major paper will endanger your graduation.
 - 60% projects.....everything that is sent to turnitin.com
 - 40% everything else
