



# FAHRENHEIT 451 FINAL PROJECT



Sophomore English 10 students will read *Fahrenheit 451* in class. Phones will be basketed during our read times. We will have a final *Fahrenheit 451* project. The project consists of a poster, a paper, and a presentation. Everything due THE week following completion of novel May 5-8

## BEGIN

- Partner not necessary but you can have 1 only 1. **MEET though technology NOT in person**
  - A partner from another class is possible but both must present at the meeting.
- Identify a line or passage that can be socially related to 2020
  - Passage should be a stand alone socially conscious expression of an idea
    - Line should not have a direct novel reference. NO names etc...
    - Example....cannot use *'We need to be really bothered once in a while.*
  - Only one passage per presenting group. Sign it up with page number, quote, and student names VIA EMAIL so others do not copy

## PAPER

- You will write a *partner* paper using the line or passage as the focus. If you have a partner
- 5 paragraph Essay
  - Thesis statement at the end of introduction
- Mule Rules
- Main points will be the significance of the passage and direct correlation to 2020
  - Why is line important to the novel?
  - Where is this connected today? **MUST identify symbolic nature of passage.**
  - How might this have a future impact on society? Where will this be relevant?

## POSTER

- You will then create an artful VISUAL
  - Use presentation software that you can share with group during ZOOM meeting
- Poster will contain written passage with page number
- Artful representation of the line. Either novel connected or 2020 connected.
  - Or both

## PRESENTATION

- Present VISUAL to a group of 6 or more in ZOOM

## EVALUATION

## **PRESENTATION**

2 minute planned and prepared presentation of your poster

### **PRESENTATION MUST:**

Have an introduction

Have focus statement clarifying the direction of your presentation

Have 2+ identifiable separate points

Have definite use of 4PEAS

Have conclusion that wraps up entirety of information

### **PRESENTATION STUFF**

Outline non sentences with sub points (optional) BP

5 point deduction per 10 seconds short

Proper speaking techniques must be evident

**INTRO/FOCUS & CONCLUSION 10**

**ORGANIZATION AND INFORMATION (symbolic nature of passage) 30**

**POSTER COLLABORATION/NEATNESS/CONNECTION evident 30**

**SPEAKING SKILLS 10**
